PRINCIPLES OF BIBLICAL LEADERSHIP 101

II. Course Description:

A study of the models of leadership with special emphasis on the biblical perspective. The characteristics and skills of successful leadership, along with the challenges associated with leadership will be discussed.

III. Course Rationale:

Foundational to an application of biblical principles of leadership in life and ministry is an exposure to and understanding of a biblical theology and practice of leadership as seen in the scriptures. An introduction to recent biblical leadership literature is also essential in order to demonstrate how godly individuals have continued to flesh out timeless truths in their leadership responsibilities.

IV. Course Objectives:

Students completing this course shall be able to:

- A. Describe the calling and life-long development of godly leaders.
- B. List and describe character qualities and disciplines essential to biblical leadership.
- C. Identify the unique tests, costs, and perils of leadership.
- D. List and describe the temporal and eternal rewards of leadership.
- E. Explain the importance and methods of identifying and mentoring new leaders.
- F. List the leadership changes that the student will make in their lives as a result of taking this course.
- G. List and describe predominant historic models and theories of leadership.
- H. For each leader to grow in faith and identify their personal values, mission, and vision for ministry.
- I. For each leader to be encouraged to use the resources that God has given them to be the effective spiritual leader that God has called them to be.
- J. For each leader to develop trusting relationships with other leaders.
- K. For each leader to choose an accountability partner to share and pray with and for.

VII. Materials and Methods of Instruction:

The following methods will be employed in this course: Reading, lecture videos, Infusion videos, leadership philosophy paper, mid-term exam.

VIII. Course Requirements:

A. Exams: Two exams will be given on assigned reading and class videos. Preparation for the exams will necessitate a careful reading of the textbook and notes taken during class videos.

B. Freedom In Christ Videos by Infusion Ministries (www.infusionnow.org). There are a significant number of videos for you to watch each week. Some are short and some are longer. You will need to make a commitment to watch these videos each week if you desire to get the most out of this opportunity.

C. Biblical Leadership Philosophy Paper – **FINAL PAPER**

Each student will write his/her own philosophy of biblical leadership covering the major themes studied in this course (see “Course Outline” above). This should go beyond theory and include practically how these themes actually are part of your life. It may include areas where your philosophy does not match up with your practice and therefore should be changed. There should be at least two scripture references for each major theme in support of your belief. The paper should be no less than four pages and no more than six pages (12 point font with one inch margins – double spaced). A title page and bibliography should be included (NOT counted as part of the suggested 4 to 6 page length). **This should be a highly personal and practical paper. Your personality with its strengths and weaknesses should be considered as you**

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write this paper. Due Date: When you turn in the second exam.
